Daniel graduated from the National University of Singapore with a Bachelor of Accountancy (Honours). He is a Fellow Chartered Accountant (Singapore) and a Fellow Certified Public Accountant (Australia). He held the Certified Information Systems Auditor qualification from 1993 to 1996 whilst he was focusing on computer auditing.

Daniel spent more than 14 years in a Big Four audit firm, including three years in its London's practice before joining the venture capitalist division of Korean conglomerate as its General Manager. He then joined Dutch listed company as its Managing Director for Singapore and later as Managing Director for Singapore and Malaysia.

Daniel was with the NUS Business School as an associate professor for eight years, since NUS Business School restarted its accounting undergraduate programme. He was module coordinator for Accounting Information Systems, Assurance and Attestation and Advanced Assurance and Attestation.
